

# International Dodge Ball Federation's 2005 College National Invitational Championships



'King of the Sand 2005'

Televised by CSTV from Panama City Beach Florida the Third Week of March

**Tournament Format:** Single Elimination Tournament seeded by Round Robin Pool Play. The tournament will be scheduled for three days.

**Teams:** Male 6 player teams (though a co-ed pick up tournament will also be held during the event!)

**Eligibility:** All Players on any one team must be currently enrolled in the same college and in good standing at the time of the tournament. A letter from the Intramural or Recreational Sports Director of the school must certify eligibility and be included with the tournament registration application and fee.

**Fee:** Each application/registration shall be submitted with two checks. The first check shall be a \$50 non-refundable application fee. The second check shall be a \$350 tournament fee processed only if the team is found to be eligible after review. Teams not found to be eligible for play for any reason shall have their tournament fee check returned but will forfeit their non-refundable application fee. (Fees submitted after the bracket is full shall be refunded 100%)

**Rules:** The tournament will be played in accordance with the rules of the IDBF as amended at the time of the tournament. A full rules package will be mailed to each eligible applicant after clearing of tournament fees. There will be two sanctioned national rated officials and two linesmen. Generally, matches will be the best of five games with the exception of the final which will be best of seven. All decisions of the tournament director will be binding and final without exception or protest.

**Accommodations:** A block of rooms will be available at a special rate at the event center, but all rooms, travel, living, and other expenses shall be the responsibility of the players.

**Uniforms:** Uniform rules will be enforced. Generally, all players on a team shall wear the same numbered uniform in accordance with the rules in effect at the time of the tournament. All uniform graphics shall be submitted to the IDBF tournament committee for review prior to tournament time. Generally, uniforms will be checked for obscene / promotional / or other objectionable text or graphics not suitable for broadcast. Teams not wearing the uniform approved prior to the tournament shall forfeit their right to continue in the tournament and forfeit their tournament fees.

**Bracket Limit:** The first 36 approved teams will be eligible for play. Preference will be given to State colleges.
